EPA DEFINES ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE AS...

“the fair treatment and meaningful involvement of all people regardless of race, color, national origin, or income with respect to the development, implementation and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations and policies.”

In 1994, under Executive Order 12898, **environmental justice** was recognized as a federal initiative administered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Since then, the environmental justice movement has expanded, becoming a focus for many state regulatory agencies. Recognizing that *marginalized groups*, including *People of Color* and *low-income communities*,^{*} bear the burden of the most polluted areas in the country, many state agencies are dedicated to ensuring their equal representation in environmental issues and protecting from environmental harm.

Principles of environmental justice, first expressed 30 years ago at the First National People of Color Environmental Leadership Summit, have returned to center stage. The Biden Administration and Michael Regan, Administrator of the EPA, have elevated the importance of environmental justice through wide-ranging actions, including creation of two related White House councils, legislation to provide funding under the American Rescue Plan and Inflation Reduction acts, development of guidance for cumulative impact assessment that reflects environmental justice concerns, and directives to all offices within EPA (<https://joebiden.com/environmental-justice-plan/>).

^{*}Accurately naming affected populations is important in the context of environmental justice. We have identified these specific naming conventions with use of italics throughout.

Myriad approaches to environmental justice exist across state agencies. Some states have started enacting their own laws whereas others have included environmental justice within existing provisions for protection of public health. Understanding each state’s existing environmental justice programs, objectives, and guiding regulations is a challenging but vitally important component in assessing and mitigating environmental health risk to *overburdened communities*.

Integral Consulting Inc. initially evaluated environmental justice initiatives and regulations in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and all U.S. territories in 2021. Information was collected through standardized internet searches and compiled for each state and territory to the extent that information was publicly available. We understand states may be in the process of updating guidelines and policies and that environmental justice initiatives will continue to evolve. Therefore, Integral incorporates regular updates into this compendium. The month and year of the latest update can be found on the cover page and in the footer of each information page.

✓ California Environmental Protection Agency

- Provides environmental justice grants to support eligible organizations in efforts to address environmental justice issues in affected areas
- Reports to the governor and legislature every three years regarding progress on objective in 2004 Intra-Agency Environmental Justice Strategy
- Uplifts and invests in community science
- Collaborates with racial equity team to ensure public health, improve and maintain environmental quality, and vitalize the green economy for all Californians
- Works with six boards, departments, and offices to implement environmental justice principles into internal and public missions
- Partners with environmental justice Liaisons
- Updates Disadvantaged Communities Designation to reduce greenhouse gas pollution and safeguard communities

✓ Environmental Justice Task Force

- Composed of members and advisory members from 12 of California’s boards, departments, and offices
- Increases compliance and enforcement in environmental justice areas
- Identifies disproportionately impacted areas

State Government Regulations

✓ **SB 535**

- Establishes initial requirements for minimum funding levels to Disadvantaged Communities (DACs)
- Gives CalEPA the responsibility for identifying DACs

✓ **2004 Intra-Agency Environmental Justice Strategy**

- Product of a multiyear collaboration between CalEPA and stakeholders
- Ensures meaningful public participation in environmental decision-making processes
- Integrates environmental justice into environmental law, regulations, and policies
- Improves research and data collection to address environmental justice issues
- Ensures effective coordination and accountability in addressing environmental justice issues

✓ **Greenhouse Gases—Investment Plan: Disadvantaged Communities**

- Makes amendments to the California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006
- Requires an increase in available money allocated to *low-income and/or disadvantaged communities*

✓ **California Government Code 65040.12**

- Proposes methods for equitable distribution of government resources to increase community quality of life

- Build relationships with communities and across sectors to address root causes of health disparities
- Use equity in decision-making and partner with all sectors of government to embed health and equity considerations into their decision-making process
- Use data to support the narrative of the social determinants of health and tell the story of what creates health
- De-center communications from the English language or any one dominant language, and prioritize language justice when engaging with communities
- Develop, implement, and provide guidance on health equity training, practice, and policies within the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and across the state of Colorado

State Agencies and Programs That Manage Environmental Justice Issues

✓ [Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection \(CTDEEP\)](#)

- Assesses the effectiveness of CTDEEP efforts in the state's urban areas

State Government Regulations

✓ **Public Act 20-6**

- Requires applicants seeking a permit for a new or expanded "applicable facility" that is proposed to be located in an "environmental justice community," to file an Environmental Justice Public Participation Plan with and receive approval from CTDEEP **prior** to filing any application for such permit
- Requires the facility to enter an environmental benefit agreement if the facility must file under chapter 277a or if the proposed facility is in a municipality with five or more affecting facilities
- Requires public opportunity for residents of the community to express requirements or needs to be included in the agreement

Approaches for Environmental Justice Activities:

- Public Notice Hearings and Receipt of Public Comments: Illinois EPA established a public participation strategy for permits in environmental justice communities; Illinois EPA works with communities to address environmental concerns regarding proposed facilities; meeting then held in and around affected community
- Informational meetings allow for meetings outside those required by law, allows for public participation in permitting process
- Permitting Actions: if concerns regarding environmental impacts in an environmental justice area are brought up the Illinois EPA will look into information provided and other available information to address potential for adverse health impacts; the Illinois EPA will conduct assessment or request assessment if there are potential adverse impacts; assessment will be available to the public

✓ [SB0090](#)

- “Requiring the Department of the Environment to create and maintain a database of supplemental environmental projects that the Department may consider for implementation as part of a settlement of an enforcement action; and requiring the Department to prioritize the selection of a supplemental environmental project located in the same geographic area as the alleged violation and to ensure that the scope and cost of a chosen project are sufficient to allow the Department and the alleged violator to reach a settlement.”

State Agencies and Programs That Manage Environmental Justice Issues

✓ Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection

- Establish state environmental justice policy
- Engage environmental justice populations in environmental decision-making through expanded and inclusive outreach, to minimize health risks through targeted environmental enforcement
- Improve environmental quality in all communities through initiatives that include reduction of pollutants and emissions, remediation and redevelopment of contaminated land, and investment in urban parks and greenspace

✓ Environmental Justice Task Force

- Develops a secretariat-wide environmental justice strategy to promote environmental, energy, and climate justice across the commonwealth in ways that are tailored to the Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs mission

✓ Environmental Justice Council

- Advises and provides recommendations to the Secretary of the Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs on relevant policies and standards to achieve environmental justice principles
- Conducts a comprehensive analysis every 5 years to ensure the definition of environmental justice population achieves the objectives of the environmental justice principles

- Accepts and investigates complaints and concerns related to environmental justice within the state of Michigan
- Establishes complaint, investigatory, informational, educational, and referral procedures and programs relating to environmental justice, coordinating with existing investigatory programs where feasible
- Establishes a statewide uniform reporting system to collect and analyze complaints about environmental justice for the purpose of publicizing improvements and significant problems, coordinating with existing programs where feasible
- Assists other departments or agencies in the resolution of complaints where necessary or appropriate
- Assists in the development, and monitors the implementation of, state and federal laws, rules, and regulations relating to environmental justice
- Recommends changes in state and federal law, rules, regulations, policies, guidelines, practices, and procedures relating to environmental justice







State Government Regulations

✓ Healthy Environment for All (HEAL) Act

- Implements findings of environmental task force
- Prevents and addresses environmental health disparities by administering ongoing and new environmental programs, and to remedy effects of past disparate treatment of *overburdened communities and vulnerable populations*
- Requires agencies to:
 - Create and adopt a community engagement plan for engagement of *overburdened and vulnerable populations*
 - Conduct environmental justice assessment to support considerations of *overburdened communities and vulnerable populations* when making decisions and equitable distribution of environmental benefits, reduction of environmental harms, and identification and reduction of environmental and health disparities
 - Incorporate environmental justice principles in decision-making processes for developing budgets, making expenditures, and granting or withholding environmental benefits
 - Have consultation framework to coordinate with tribal governments
- Establishes Environmental Justice Council

✓ Climate Commitment Act

- Implements an economywide cap and invest system to work toward the state’s goal of net-zero emission by 2050, with enforceable greenhouse gas emission reductions required in 2023
- Requires annual/biannual conducting of an Environmental Justice Assessment when allocating funds accrued in the various state treasury accounts tied to the cap and invest framework by covered agencies
- Also requires each covered agency to establish a minimum threshold of 35% of its total investments that provide direct and meaningful benefits to vulnerable populations
